## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING ROBBERY AND  
AGGRAVATED ROBBERY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING ROBBERY AND  
AGGRAVATED ROBBERY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 5-12-102(a), concerning the offense of robbery, is amended to read as follows:

(a) A person commits robbery if, with the purpose of committing a felony or misdemeanor theft or resisting apprehension immediately after committing a felony or misdemeanor theft, the person employs or threatens to immediately employ physical force, or creates a circumstance that would cause a reasonable person to believe the use of physical force is imminent, upon another person.
