## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING CONDUCT OF ELECTIONS; TO ALLOW A COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTION COMMISSIONERS TO DESIGNATE A RESTROOM FOR CAMPAIGN WORKERS AND VOLUNTEERS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING CONDUCT OF ELECTIONS; AND TO ALLOW A COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTION COMMISSIONERS TO DESIGNATE A RESTROOM FOR CAMPAIGN WORKERS AND VOLUNTEERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 7, Chapter 5, Subchapter 3, is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

7-5-325. Designated restrooms for campaign workers and volunteers.

(a) A county board of election commissioners may designate restroom facilities to be used by campaign workers or volunteers at a polling site.

(b) A campaign worker or volunteer working outside of the polling site may use restroom facilities in the polling site designated by the county board of election commissioners under subsection (a) of this section.

(c) Before entering the polling site to use the designated restroom facilities under this section, a campaign worker or volunteer:

(1) Shall cover or remove campaign material advocating voting for or against a:

(A) Candidate; or



(B) Position on a ballot measure;

(2) Shall not attempt to solicit votes; and

(3) Shall not interact or engage with a poll worker.

(d) A campaign worker or volunteer who enters the polling site and violates subsection (c) of this section is guilty of electioneering under § 7-1-103(a)(8).
