# A Bill

## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING ALCOHOLIC  
BEVERAGES; TO AUTHORIZE BOTTLE LOCKERS IN CERTAIN  
RESTAURANTS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING ALCOHOLIC  
BEVERAGES; AND TO AUTHORIZE BOTTLE  
LOCKERS IN CERTAIN RESTAURANTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 3, Chapter 9, Subchapter 2, is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

3-9-243. Bottle lockers in restaurants – Definition.

(a) As used in this section, "bottle locker" means a storage system, such as an individual locker or cabinet, within a restaurant where the restaurant stores bottles of alcoholic beverages purchased and for consumption by a guest for which the guest pays a storage fee to the restaurant.

(b) A restaurant located in a wet territory that has been issued an on-premises consumption permit to sell and serve alcoholic beverages may offer to a guest of the restaurant the option of the use of a bottle locker to store alcoholic beverages for later consumption at the restaurant by the guest.
