WHEREAS, the North Little Rock High School Charging Wildcats Varsity Cheer Team won the Class 6A all-girl state championship held on December 20, 2024; and

WHEREAS, Charging Wildcats team members are Aspen Frensley, Avery Bilon, Caitlin Jones, Ciriah Dunn, Iyuana Jones, Kamryn Cottrell, Kylie Sartain, Leila Patton, Mallori Holloway, Nia Salaam, and Rikki Jimmerson, and alternates Abby McCandless, Brooklyn Theodore, Evin Lawson, Jasiah Stith, and Jenna Harrelson; and

WHEREAS, in additional to winning the state championship, the Charging Wildcats attended four (4) competitions prior to the state championship and placed first in three (3) of the four (4) competitions and placed third in one (1) of the four (4) competitions; and

WHEREAS, team member Iyuana Jones earned All-State Cheerleader honors; and



WHEREAS, team members Iyuana Jones and Kylie Sartain earned All-Star Honors; and

WHEREAS, the Charging Wildcats also traveled to Orlando, Florida, for the National High School Cheerleading Championships in February 2025 and placed eighth in a field of forty-three (43) teams; and

WHEREAS, Coach Missy Sela said of the win, "This team worked incredibly hard during the season and won the 6A all-girl division with only eleven cheerleaders on the mat, [which is] a first for a team to have that few members win in the 6A division",
