TO HONOR 2024 MISS ARKANSAS' TEEN BELLA CROWE.

WHEREAS, Bella Crowe is a seventeen-year-old senior at Benton High School who assumed the responsibilities and title of Miss Arkansas' Teen 2024 in February after her predecessor, Peyton Bolling, was crowned Miss America's Teen on January 4, 2025, in Orlando, Florida; and

WHEREAS, for serving as Miss Arkansas' Teen, Bella Crowe will receive a scholarship in the amount of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) provided by Jones & Son Diamond & Bridal Fine Jewelry and the Miss Arkansas Scholarship Foundation; and

WHEREAS, during the Miss Arkansas' Teen pageant held on June 14, 2024, at Robinson Center Performance Hall in Little Rock, Bella Crowe took home a total of thirteen thousand three hundred seventy-five dollars (\$13,375) in scholarships; and

WHEREAS, at the Miss Arkansas' Teen pageant, Bella Crowe also won the Overall Vocalist Award and the #KissHeartDiseaseGoodbye Award, and was the Teens in Action overall winner; and

WHEREAS, at the Miss Arkansas' Teen pageant, Bella Crowe gave a vocal performance of Giacomo Puccini's legendary Italian aria, "O Mio Babbino



Caro"; and

WHEREAS, throughout her year serving as Miss Arkansas' Teen, Bella Crowe will make appearances across Arkansas promoting her personal community service initiative, "Healthy Choices for Healthy Teens", the American Heart Association, Miss Arkansas Opportunities, and Miss America Opportunities; and

WHEREAS, Bella Crowe competed for three (3) years at Miss Arkansas' Teen, representing local titles of Saline County's Teen in 2024, Greater Little Rock's Teen in 2023, and Metro's Teen in 2022; and

WHEREAS, throughout her time competing at the state level in Arkansas, Bella Crowe has won a total of nearly seventeen thousand dollars (\$17,000) in scholarships; and

WHEREAS, after Bella Crowe graduates from high school, she plans to use the scholarships she has won through Miss America Opportunity to attend college at the University of Alabama, where she will pursue a degree in Exercise and Nutrition Science with a goal of becoming a registered dietitian and professional sports nutritionist; and

WHEREAS, Bella Crowe attended the White House Conference on Hunger, Nutrition, and Health during autumn 2022 as a representative of the American Heart Association; and

WHEREAS, Bella Crowe started "Beyond Fruit Carts", an organization that provides fresh fruits to public schools in central Arkansas; and

WHEREAS, at Benton High School, Bella Crowe is involved in National Honor Society, BHS Serve, Med Pro Club, Outdoors Club, and the City of Benton Mayor's Youth Advisory Council; and

WHEREAS, Bella Crowe is the daughter of Aaron and Amber Crowe of Benton, the granddaughter of Bob and Teresa Devine and Gay Burt and the late Keith Crowe, and has one older sister, Katherine,
