16 WHEREAS, on Friday, June 13, 2025, Amelia Lisowe, of Benton, Arkansas,
17 representing Miss Greater Little Rock's Teen, was crowned Miss Arkansas' Teen
18 2025 at the Robinson Center in Little Rock, Arkansas; and
19

20 WHEREAS, Amelia Lisowe is the fourteen-year-old daughter of Lauren
21 Lisowe, and is a freshman at Bryant Junior High School; and
22

23 WHEREAS, Amelia Lisowe is the founder of Lisowe's Lights, a nonprofit
24 organization dedicated to providing night lights to children in foster care,
25 offering comfort and a sense of security during uncertain times; and
26

27 WHEREAS, since its creation, Lisowe's Lights has distributed more than
28 thirty-seven thousand (37,000) night lights across all fifty (50) states and
29 ten (10) countries, impacting countless young lives; and

31 WHEREAS, Amelia Lisowe's service and leadership have earned national
32 recognition, including appearances on The Jennifer Hudson Show, NBC Nightly
33 News Kids with Lester Holt: Kids Edition, and Good Morning America; and

35 WHEREAS, Amelia Lisowe is a six-time Gold Presidential Volunteer
36 Service awardee with more than nine hundred (900) volunteer hours since 2019;

3 WHEREAS, Amelia Lisowe's other achievements include appearing on Elmo's
4 Road Trip for the fiftieth anniversary season of Sesame Street, traveling to
5 twenty (20) states and six (6) countries, and being a paid choreographer at
6 the age of eleven (11); and

8 WHEREAS, on the Miss Arkansas' Teen stage, Amelia Lisowe showcased her
9 artistic talents with a moving lyrical dance to Whitney Houston's "I Have
10 Nothing"; and

11

12 WHEREAS, while on the Miss Arkansas' Teen stage, Amelia Lisowe answered
13 questions about how she could help foster kids, how she could address
14 stereotypes surrounding Miss Arkansas, and what she wished to accomplish
15 during her reign if crowned Miss Arkansas' Teen 2025; and

16

17 WHEREAS, for her community service and her performance on the Miss
18 Arkansas' Teen stage, Amelia Lisowe earned more than sixteen thousand dollars
19 (\$16,000) in scholarships; and

20

21 WHEREAS, Amelia Lisowe has earned full-ride scholarships to the
22 University of Alabama, Arkansas State University, and Mississippi State
23 University; and

24

25 WHEREAS, Amelia Lisowe is the youngest person to ever receive a
26 scholarship offer from Mississippi State University; and

27

28 WHEREAS, in her role as Miss Arkansas' Teen 2025, Amelia Lisowe serves
29 as a role model and ambassador for the Miss Arkansas Scholarship Organization
30 and promotes community service, leadership, and educational excellence; and

31

32 WHEREAS, Amelia Lisowe represented the State of Arkansas at the Miss
33 America's Teen competition in September 2025; and

34

35 WHEREAS, Amelia Lisowe continues to serve as a role model to Arkansans
36 and is continuing her mission to bring light and hope to foster children,
