## 8 **SENATE RESOLUTION**

9 TO RECOGNIZE THE PARKVIEW ARTS AND SCIENCES MAGNET  
10 HIGH SCHOOL PATRIOTS BOYS' BASKETBALL TEAM AS THE  
11 2026 CLASS 5A STATE CHAMPIONS.

### 13 **Subtitle**

14 TO RECOGNIZE THE PARKVIEW ARTS AND  
15 SCIENCES MAGNET HIGH SCHOOL PATRIOTS  
16 BOYS' BASKETBALL TEAM AS THE 2026 CLASS  
17 5A STATE CHAMPIONS.

20 WHEREAS, the Parkview Arts and Sciences Magnet High School Patriots  
21 boys' basketball team clinched the Class 5A state basketball championship in  
22 an overtime win against the Marion High School Patriots at Bank OZK Arena in  
23 Hot Springs, Arkansas, on March 14, 2026, with a final score of sixty-three  
24 to fifty-seven (63-57); and  
25

26 WHEREAS, the Patriots made a remarkable turnaround this season, surging  
27 from a team with four (4) wins and twenty-five (25) losses in the 2024-2025  
28 season to a team with an impressive twenty-eight (28) wins and five (5)  
29 losses and an overall conference record of fifteen (15) wins and one (1) loss  
30 during the 2025-2026 season; and

32 WHEREAS, the Patriots were led to victory by Head Coach Jason Harrison,  
33 a former Patriots basketball player who graduated from Parkview Magnet High  
34 School in 1998; and

36 WHEREAS, Head Coach Jason Harrison was awarded the 5A Arkansas



1 Basketball Coaches Association Coach of the Year, 2026 5A Central Boys' Coach  
2 of the Year, and The Arkansas-Democrat Gazette 2026 Boys' Coach of the Year;

5 WHEREAS, the Patriots were also led by assistant coaches Antoni Lasker,  
6 Chanslor Watson, and Jamahl Jackson and assisted by team manager Josiah  
7 Carlock and special assistant Jacob Robert Harrison; and  
8

9 WHEREAS, Patriots team members include Kolby Bell, Jermaine Conway,  
10 Chris Edwards, Jonathan Geter, Keithan Green, Ayden Hansberry, Kedric  
11 Humphrey, Jr., Jacob Lanier, Callen McCray, Tyrian Thompson, Christian  
12 Washington, Bruce Williams, Jr., Bryan Williams, and Joshua Wills; and  
13

14 WHEREAS, outstanding duo Jacob Lanier and Ayden Hansberry pushed the  
15 team into victory during overtime, scoring all fourteen (14) of the points  
16 for the Patriots during overtime; and  
17

18 WHEREAS, senior Jacob Lanier, a four-star shooting guard who recently  
19 committed to the University of Nebraska Cornhuskers men's basketball team,  
20 finished his season scoring over nine hundred (900) points, earning the title  
21 of the Class 5A State Championship Most Valuable Player, and being named to  
22 the All-State, All-Conference, and All-Tournament teams; and  
23

24 WHEREAS, late Patriots coach Al Flanigan, who passed away in December  
25 2025, told the team right before his death that they would "win state title,"  
26 to which Head Coach Jason Harrison, after winning the state championship,  
27 responded, "If he were here, I'd be looking him dead in his eyes and say,  
28 'Man, you were right.'"; and  
29

30 WHEREAS, Head Coach Jason Harrison commented on the Patriots' victory,  
31 stating "[t]hese kids worked. There's been a lot of peaks and valleys, ups  
32 and downs, but through it all, we stayed the course. We lost some games, and  
33 we learned from them. Every loss was a lesson, and we turned it into fuel",
