WHEREAS, lineworkers put their lives on the line every day with little recognition from the community regarding the danger of their work; and

WHEREAS, it is most fitting and proper that the lineworkers of Arkansas be recognized for their effective and dedicated service to the people of the State of Arkansas,

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-FIFTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

THAT the Senate proclaim April 21, 2026, as Arkansas Lineworker Appreciation Day at the State Capitol and commend, on behalf of their constituents, the men and women who serve Arkansas as utility lineworkers for their efforts in keeping the power on and protecting public safety.
