#### **Part 156. Rules for Testing, Identification, Movement, and Meeting the National Poultry Improvement Plan Requirements**

##### **Subpart 1. Generally**

###### **2 CAR § 156-101. Purpose.**

This part is promulgated by the authority of the designation of the Arkansas Board of Animal Health as an official state agency authorized to cooperate with the United States Department of Agriculture, Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service in the administration of the NPIP.

###### **2 CAR § 156-102. Incorporation by reference of National Poultry Improvement Plan Standards.**

The Arkansas Board of Animal Health hereby incorporates by reference the National Poultry Improvement Plan Standards, as amended by the United States Department of Agriculture, Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service from time to time, as provisions of this part as though set forth herein line for line and word for word.
